DYNAMIC METHODOLOGY FOR FRENCH TEACHING IN THE PRIMARY CLASSROOM

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course is based on a balanced activities approach that combines communicative tasks, which improve the ability to communicate, with controlled language presentation and practice, which improve the quality of the communication. The main focus is on spoken communication and the sessions are conducted in French.

One important aspect of the course is practice sharing. Teaching techniques and ideas for classroom activities that foster language learning are presented, discussed and shared throughout the course. Ideas and resources can be prepared beforehand

Cultural activities outside class time are linked to the teaching content giving participants the chance to use and practice recently acquired language in a natural situation thus increasing participants' confidence as well as cultural awareness and therefore their effectiveness as MFL teachers.

This course requires knowledge of basic French and is therefore not suitable for beginners.

AIMS

- To improve expertise in the teaching of primary level French.
- To improve fluency, competence and confidence in spoken French with a view to increasing the use of target language in class.
- To evaluate existing teaching materials and methodology and to develop new materials and strategies for classroom use.
- To develop methods of integrating French within the teaching of other curricular subjects.
- To improve cultural awareness of contemporary France and Francophone countries.
- To increase awareness of the European dimension and cross-cultural issues.

FOLLOW UP

Participants will receive a certificate at the end of the course and will have the opportunity to join a European network of course participants which will be supported by an email forum for regular communications.
